Step-by-Step Islamic Wudu For Brothers/Sisters

How To Perform Wudu?

“Wudu” is an Arabic word means cleanness. It is an act of worship, performed with using water to wash certain organs in a certain manner.

What are Wudu steps in Quran?

Steps:

1. Make intention for Wudu in your heart or mind

Start with making niyyah or intention. Make intention in your mind or heart that you are about to perform wudu.



2. Say “Bismillah” (In the Name of Allah)

Say bismillah before starting Wudu either out-loud or silently in your head.

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ
الرَّحْمَنِ الرَّحِيمِ

Bismillah ir-Rahman ir-Rahim

3. Wash Hands 3 times

Wash both your hands 3 times. Use your one hand to wash your other hand, between the fingers and wrist.



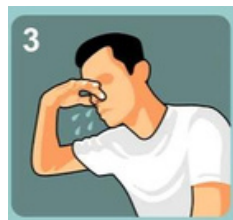
4. Wash Mouth 3 times

Take some water into your right hand and rinse your mouth three times with it. Swish the water thoroughly to clean your mouth and then spit it out.



5. Wash Nose 3 times

Rinse your nose three times. Take some water into your right hand, and inhale it into your nose (Not too much). Use your left hand to blow out the water and repeat it three times.



6. Wash Face 3 times

Wash your whole face three times, from the hairline to the chin and from ear to ear, eyebrows, under the nose and lips. A man should wash the hair of his beard. Make sure water reaches the skin.



7. Wash your Arms 3 times

Start from the tips of the fingers of your right arm to above your elbow. Repeat this three times. Do the same for your left 3 times.



8. Wipe your Head One time

Wipe your head with your hands. Move your wet hands from the top of the forehead to the back of the head, and then from the back of the head to the forehead one time.



9. Clean your ears One time

Clean your ears using your wet hands. Use your index finger to clean the inside of your ears and wipe your thumb to clean the back of your ears 1 time.



10. Wipe your neck One time

Pass the back side of the wet hands over the back of the neck



11. Wash your Feet 3 times

Wash the right foot from tip of the fingers, between the finger with your little finger to the ankle, sole of the foot, heel and back of the ankle (Three Times). Do the same for left 3 times.



12. Closing Du'a

Finish your wudu with the dua:

Ash-hadu 'an laa 'ilaaha 'il-lal-laa-huwah-dahulaa shareeka-lah, wa'ash-hadu'anna Muhammadan 'ab-duhu wa Rasooluh.

Translation: I bear witness that none has the right to be worshipped but Allah alone, who has no partner; and I bear witness that Muhammad is His slave and His Messenger.

Following is **another Dua** which can be recited after performing ablution/wudu:

Allahum-maj-AAal-neeminat-tawwabeenawajAAalneeminal-mutatahhireen.

Translation: O Allah, make me of those who return to You often in repentance and make me of those who remain clean and pure.
